FLORIDA-BRED TWO YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Sunday, October 27. \$750 to enter. \$75,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a stakes allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 4 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters. Preference will be given to stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile).

CAPTAIN D vied three deep for the early lead going by the wire for the first turn, taken in hand and edged back and stalked in close range down the backstretch, let out a notch and matched strides with GENGHIS around the far turn, assumed command turning for home, roused for more, responded sharply and finished going away. REBELDE settled nicely and saved ground down the backstretch, angled out and roused for more around the far turn, set down driving five wide in the lane, finished with response and cleared place. GENGHIS advanced out of the first turn and challenged PLATO for the early lead, matched strides down the backstretch then dueled inside of CAPTAIN D around the far turn, could not match strides with eventual winner at head of the lane, kept under steady pressure and stayed on for share. YES FOR LESS rated off the top trio down the backstretch, urged to pick up the pace past the three eighths pole, raced three to four wide in range in upper stretch then finished evenly. PLATO led the way around the first turn then challenged by GENGHIS and vied for the lead down the backstretch, could not match with the top pair entering the far turn but continued with interest up the inside then had no late kick. MR. WHO raced along the outside never too far back off the early pace, drifted out wide leaving the backstretch and had no response when called upon.
