Footnotes

ABOVE THE MOON away alertly and raced to the lead through the first turn while saving ground at the rail, opened a clear advantage entering the final turn, and was never seriously threatened late. CAPILANO CANYON tracked the leaders into the backstretch while racing two out from the rail, rallied two wide through the final turn, and finished evenly late to prove clearly second best. AT ATTENTION drifted out entering the first turn, carrying ATOMIC HAZE out with him, stalked the early pace four wide entering the backstretch, rallied three wide through the final turn, and finished two out from the rail in the drive to be along for a share. NORTHERN KID unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied along the inside entering the final turn, and finished three wide in the drive. ATOMIC HAZE away well and settled off the early pace while being carried out through the first turn, rallied two wide through the final turn, but was unable to make a late impact while finishing from between rivals in deep stretch. DESERT HILLS broke sharply and pressed the leader into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, struggled to keep pace with that rival entering the final turn, and weakened from along the rail in the drive.
