If more than twelve horses pass the entry box, preference will be given to high weights, highest earnings will then be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. SHES THE CAUSE was unhurried while in the two path through the turn, angled into the four path entering the lane, commenced in a long drive from the four or five path, steadily inched up late and just got up. LADY ALLY was in the four to the two path through the turn, came into the lane with momentum and from the three path with another rival, put away the leader outside the eighth pole, put away another inside the sixteenth pole, led very late and was just caught. MINTCHOCOLATECHIP was void of early speed while in the three to the four path through the turn, came into the lane from the four path and finished willingly to be closing in late. BETCHA chased the pace from the three path through the turn, came into the lane from the two path, bid with the

runner-up in upper stretch, was still a contender approaching the sixteenth pole then yielded. SUPER JEN was in the two path through the turn while well back, angled into the three to the five path into the lane then finished with good energy although belatedly. DONTYOUREMEMBER was in the two or three path through the turn, came into the lane from the four or five path and offered a mild gain. C J'S EMPIRE raced in the two path through the turn and into the lane, was not far back after straightening in the lane, rider lost whip inside the three-sixteenths pole then weakened. NOTHINGBUTFLOWERS stumbled badly at the start, raced well back and in the four to the five path through the turn, came into the lane from widest lane and improved position. LUCKY FEVER set the pace along the inside through the turn then gave way after entering the lane. ONLY REWARD'S raced in the three path to the rail through the turn when never far back and was done entering the lane. SENTIMENTALJOURNEY was along the inside through the turn and steadily faded. RELEASE THE HEAT chased the pace from the two path through mid-turn, began to retreat near the five-sixteenths pole and was eased to the wire and walked off.
