### Footnotes

TIZ THE BOMB raced back early on, was in the seven path into the lane, worked back closer to the rail down the lane, inched clear and held sway in the final stages. KISS THE SKY was unhurried early on, raced in the seven path into the lane, rallied down the lane, drifted in a bit and was gaining in the final stages. PLAY ACTION PASS dueled early on, was in the five path into the lane, drew clear near the quarter pole but yielded late in the stretch run. RED RUN raced back early on, was in the seven path into the lane, rallied down the lane and moved up in the late stages. NOBALS stalked the pace early, was in the seven path into the lane and weakened late in the stretch drive. ON THIN ICE chased the pace early, was in the five path into the lane and leveled off late in the stretch. LONGSHADOW stalked the pace early, was in the four path into the lane and faded late. FAN THE FIRE was never a threat. RUMBLE STRIP RON was never a factor. CALL ME GUSTO was through after three quarters.
