WIN WIN was bumped at the start and raced back early on, steadied near the five sixteenth pole, fanned into the five path in the far turn, rallied down the lane, was rolling late and was up for place in the final stages. SIGNALMAN stalked the pace early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch, battled down the lane, inched clear for place but lost it at the wire. SOMELIKEITHOTBROWN set the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and leveled off late in the stretch drive. SO ALIVE was in tight a bit after leaving the gate and raced back early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn and leveled off late in the stretch drive. SO ALIVE was in tight a bit after leaving the gate and raced back early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. SIR WINSTON was bumped at the start and raced back early on, was bothered near the five sixteenth pole, swung into the six path in the far turn and improved position down the lane. ADMIRE came out at the start, chased the pace early, was asked along the far turn but had no response and was no factor thereafter. MARKET KING stalked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn and was no factor. DREAM MAKER fought restraint along the first turn and into the backstretch then was through after a half. PARSIMONY chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and was tired down the lane.
