UNI (GB) rated kindly in midpack along the inside around the first turn, inched closer down the backstretch before tipping three wide into the far turn, sustained her advance turning or home while being floated to the five path by NEWSPAPEROFRECORD (IRE), but took dead aim as that foe cleared in upper stretch, reached even terms passing the furlong pole, and drove clear in the final sixteenth. BEAU RECALL (IRE) trailed the field around both turns, came into the lane in the three path before shifting to the five path in upper stretch, then rallied outside of foes through the lane, and was gaining on the eventual winner in the late stages while prevailing over NEWSPAPEROFRECORD (IRE) for place at the wire. NEWSPAPEROFRECORD (IRE) allowed CRYSTAL LAKE to clear off into the first turn, stalked that foe from the two path down the backstretch while just a bit headstrong, inched closer into the far turn to produce a bid for the lead at the five sixteenths pole as UNI (GB) ranged alongside, shifted to the four path turning for home to float that foe wider, took over and cleared off in upper stretch, but met a stiff challenge from UNI (GB) at the furlong pole, got headed by that foe at the sixteenth pole, yielded through the closing stages, and was nailed on the wire for place. DALIKA (GER) stumbled at the start and got rank from restrained right after, raced off of the pace in the two path while keen around the first turn, advanced to striking position from the pocket around the far turn as the field bunch up, but failed to produce a bid through the lane. CRYSTAL LAKE was off slowly, rushed to clear the field into the first turn, opened up down the backstretch, but tired into the far turn, saw her lead evaporate by the five sixteenths pole, then wilted through the lane.
