Footnotes

BOWIES HERO was back early along the three to four path, fanned into the seven path entering the lane, rallied in the stretch and edged clear in the late stages. DIAMOND OOPS dueled early on while off the rail, was on the inside into the lane, inched clear near the eighth pole but yielded in the late stages. SUEDOIS (FR) was unhurried early on, fanned into the eight path in the far turn, rallied down the lane and was gaining in the late stages. FIRST PREMIO was back early on, fanned into the eight path entering the lane, rallied down the lane and was gaining in the final stages. MARCH TO THE ARCH was bothered early on and raced along the back of the pack, fanned into the five path in the far turn, rallied down the stretch and was gaining late. NEXT SHARES raced back early along the inside, stayed on the inside entering the lane, made a bid down the lane from the rail but hung in the final stages. DIVISIDERO chased the pace early from the five path, was in the six path into the lane and flattened out late in the stretch run. VAN BEETHOVEN hopped at the start and raced back early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn, made a bid down the lane but leveled off late in the drive. BANDUA stalked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn, made a bid down the lane but hung in the late stages. VALID POINT chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn, steadied late in the stretch run and weakened in the final stages. ADMISSION OFFICE trailed the field early on, was off the rail into the lane and lacked a gain down the lane. VINTAGER (GB) chased the pace early, swung into the six path in the far turn, steadied late in the stretch, faded late. ROBIN OF NAVAN (FR) was bothered early on. REAL STORY dueled early along the five path, shifted into the three path entering the lane and folded up.
