#### Footnotes

TIZ THE BOMB broke through the gate pre-race, ran for a furlong or so before being jogged back and reloaded, stalked two wide, but lost position while chasing around the far turn as outer foes made moves, tipped six wide for clear sailing entering the lane, and produced a good kick to range up to inner foes at the furlong grounds, forged an advantage a sixteenth from home, and drove clear. STOLEN BASE sat reserved along the inside, then two wide into the far turn, swung nine wide and outside of rivals turning for home, rallied with a good kick while shifting inwards through the lane, and reached place approaching the wire. CREDIBILITY tracked from midpack along the inside, saved ground before shifting five wide in upper stretch, grinded away inside of TIZ THE BOMB, but was outkicked by that foe leaving the furlong grounds, kept on while gaining place, but lost that position late. RED DANGER was bumped hard by an outer foe at the start, then took a bump to his hind quarters from an inner rival shortly after, tracked the pace three wide got floated four wide in upper stretch, but produced a bid at the three sixteenths pole, briefly led leading to the furlong grounds, resisted outer bids leaving that junction, but was outkicked a sixteenth out. DOWAGIAC CHIEF stalked along the inside, tipped three wide entering the lane, vied for the lead between horses passing the three sixteenths pole, but yielded to outer foes at the furlong grounds. ROCKET ONE lied off of the pace two wide, got hung out five wide around the far turn, came into the lane eight wide, but was outkicked by an outer foe in midstretch while put to tight quarters on his left lead, then kept on thereafter. PLAY ACTION PASS staked two wide, bid turning for home, led in upper stretch before meeting a pair of bids at the three sixteenths pole, then gave way to them and other outer foes at the furlong grounds. LUCKY BOSS popped the gate opened when TIZ THE BOMB broke through, trailed the field two wide, saved ground around the far turn, shifted off of the railing in upper stretch, but steadied briefly in traffic at the furlong grounds, shifted inwards, but was not persevered with thereafter. ON THIN ICE was pinched back early on, saved ground far off of the pace, improved inside of foes turning for home, but failed sustain that bid. BRIT'S WIT never got involved. MARTINI'NMOONSHINE settled off of the pace, attempted a four wide rally around the far turn before swinging seven wide entering the lane, but lacked a kick. HEAVEN STREET bumped an inner foe at the start, tugged clear into the first turn, met a bid turning for home, got headed entering the lane, and stopped. FAST N STEADY was bumped between horses at the start, lied far off three wide and between rivals, then weakened into the far turn. WAITA MINUTE HAYES took a bump at the start, then got bumped between horses shortly after, lied far off of the pace four wide, was done early, and eased through the lane.
