CALIFORNIA ANGEL settled far off of the pace, took the far turn in the four to five paths before swinging eight wide entering the lane, then produced a

steady grinding rally outside of foes while hanging on her left lead to reach the leading pair on the wire. DIAMOND WOW tracked four wide, ranged up to the leaders turning for home while well in hand, produced a good kick when let out in upper stretch, rallied to bid outside of TURNERLOOSE approaching the final sixteenth, got herded outwards from that drifting foe while forging an advantage, led late, but was nailed on the wire. TURNERLOOSE set the pace along the inside, shook clear turning for home before being maneuvered to the three path entering the lane, remained clear into the final furlong, but was tested by DIAMOND WOW leaving that station, drifted out while resisting that foe's bid, but was headed a sixteenth out, continued to drift, and was bested. DRESSED lied off of the pace in the three path, gained in the five path around the far turn, managed a grinding rally through the lane while chasing between horse, but lost momentum when herded outwards in the late stages by the leaders, got outkicked approaching the wire, and leveled off. OPALINA brushed the gate while hopping a bit at the start, lied far back two wide, shifted to the four path around the far turn before swinging seven wide entering the lane, and stayed on between horses. ROUGHLY A DIAMOND saved ground while tracking the pace, but failed to produce a bid. MISTHAVEN (IRE) settled far off of the pace, took the far turn in the three path before shifting six wide entering the lane, and chased between horses through the final furlong before leveling off. KNEESNHIPS saved ground far off of the pace, moved to the five path in upper stretch, and stayed on between horses late. BHOMA stalked along the inside, but chased through upper stretch before fading through the final furlong. QUEEN JUDITH trailed, came into the lane in the seven path, and moved up. RIGBY stalked three wide, crept forward turning for home, but tired in upper stretch. BOXING DAY tracked two wide, but faded through the lane. ONTHEONESANDTWOS pressed the pace two wide, but weakened between horses turning for home. THE QUARTER MILE FRACTION WAS HAND-TIMED.
