KNICKS GO set the pace early along the inside, angled off the rail into the lane then drew off late in the stretch under a steady drive. SIGNALMAN chased the pace early while off the rail, was in tight along the rail near the five sixteenth pole, was bumped and steadied nearing the guarter pole, angled off the rail into the lane and was no match for the winner. STANDARD DEVIATION was back early along the four path, fanned into the seven path entering the lane, rallied in the stretch, made a bid but flattened out late in the drive. SOMBEYAY came out at the start, tracked the pace early while off the rail, was bumped nearing the quarter pole while between horses, altered out into the four path entering the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. DERBY DATE was back early on from the five path, shifted into the three path entering the lane while making a bid but faded late in the stretch drive. MR. ANKENY stalked the pace early from the three path, was bumped around and steadied nearing the quarter pole and was empty late in the stretch. FLUMINENSE came out at the start and raced back early from the four path, swung into the six path entering the lane and moved up in the stretch. EVERFAST bobbled and came in at the start, was no threat. TOBACCO ROAD chased the pace early along the three path, was off the rail into the lane and tired in the stretch. MOONSTER was



done early. BORRACHO chased the pace early from the four path, angled off the rail into the lane and was tired. DREAM MAKER was bumped around and clipped heels at the start. UNIONIZER was bumped around at the start and fought restraint along the first turn.
