FIRE AT WILL shifted inwards passing the wire for the first time without clearing inner foes, caused multiple rivals to be stacked up and steadied in the process, then stalked from the pocket around the turns, shifted outside of the clear leader in upper stretch, rallied to bid at the furlong pole, and drew off under driving pressure. BATTLEGROUND raced far off of the pace three wide around both turns, swung six wide turning for home, brushed SEALIWAY passing the three sixteenths pole while holding his path, then produced a rally through the late stages to get up for place approaching the wire. OUTADORE set the pace along the inside, gamely added to his margin in upper stretch, but was challenged and headed by FIRE AT WILL passing the furlong pole, then gave way on his left lead, and got nailed for place on the wire. CADILLAC (IRE) tracked from midpack two wide and between horses, inched forward through traffic in upper stretch while chasing from behind the leaders, then sustained his grinding rally, but was outkicked by BATTLEGROUND for minor rewards passing the sixteenth pole. SEALIWAY (FR) was bumped by outer foes crossing the wire for the first time, steadied due to the incident, then raced far off of the pace two wide and between horses around both turns, shifted five wide turning for home while inside of BATTLEGROUND, brushed with that foe and an inner foe when put to tight quarters passing the three sixteenths pole, then was outkicked by the prior at the furlong pole. GRETZKY THE GREAT stalked two wide, got floated three wide as his inner counterpart passing the guarter pole, then weakened between foes through the final furlong. THE LIR JET (IRE) raced far off of the pace two wide and between horses, then improved mildly through traffic through the lane. DEVILWALA (IRE) dwelt then hopped at the start, saved ground far off of the pace around the first turn, advanced to be between horses around the far turn, then mildly improved through the lane. EBEKO (IRE) lied forwardly placed three wide, but weakened passing the quarter pole. MUTASAABEQ tracked from midpack three wide around the first turn, then was floated five wide outside of NEW MANDATE (IRE) around the far turn, and never got involved. GO ATHLETICO (FR) raced far off of the pace three wide around the first turn, then four to six wide around the far turn, and failed to factor. PUBLIC SECTOR (GB) was jostled between horses crossing the wire for the first time, saved ground from midpack around both turns, but tired in upper stretch. ABARTA was pinched between foes and steadied hard passing the wire for the first time, then saved ground far off of the pace, but to no avail. NEW MANDATE (IRE) was bumped between horses passing the wire for the first time, got rank into the first turn, stayed unsettled while close to the pace two wide and between horses, but weakened into the far turn, and was eased through the lane.
