RAGING WHISKEY quickly sped to the lead while angling in some, dictated pace while three then two wide into the stretch, padded cushion in upper stretch, lugged inward through the drive, was straightened under left handed urging and scored decisively. DAPPER chased from off the rail then outside a rival, continued three or four wide into the stretch, remained well off the rail and pulled away from others to clearly prove next best. GEORGIAN ROAD was bumped from both sides leaving the gate, settled off the rail, chased four wide most of the way to the stretch and was along for a minor award. TAP BACK was lightly bumped at the start, also raced outside rival then two or three wide to the stretch and weakened late from the inside. PRINCE MAGICIAN broke in slightly and lightly bumped inside rival, chased three wide to the turn, remained off the fance and lacked any late response. SIDE STREET DAVE reserved while taken off the rail early, chased three wide, swung out five wide leaving the turn and never reached contention. HYDROGEN forced the early pace from the inside, remained prominent to the stretch then gave way steadily inside.
