EDA brushed the gate at the start, was forwardly placed three wide on the clubhouse turn, went up to take control at the nine-sixteenths pole, dueled into and around the far turn, led clear into the lane, lost command midstretch but fought back gamely and dug in to prove best in the end. CAIRO MEMORIES went four wide on the first turn, stalked the top pair outside a rival, took aim at the leader four wide leaving the second bend, continued to give chase down the lane and put in a late bid to earn the place honors. TONITO'S went two then three wide around the first turn, stalked the top pair through the middle stages, bid between in upper stretch, reached the front midstretch but faltered late and was overtaken by the top pair. DESERT DAWN traveled four then five wide on the first turn, traveled widest up the backstretch, came four wide into the drive and never threatened. BENEDICT CANYON sped to the front along the inside on the first turn, led under a hold early on the backstretch, dueled with EDA up the backstretch, battled around the second bend, chased that foe into the stretch and weakened. GRACE ADLER went three wide around the first turn, chased two wide into the second bend, lost ground around the second bend, tired in the lane, eased to the wire and walked off. THE MILE FRACTION AND FINAL TIME WERE HAND-TIMED.
