

ALWAYSMINING came away in good order then had to be rated back off the leaders entering the first turn, shifted out for a clear run in early backstretch, stalked under a light hold past the five eighths, responded when given his cue and bid three deep to command after six furlongs, went clear mid way on the final turn then pulled away under a steady hand ride. TRIFOR GOLD led three wide into the first turn then was content to track BOZZINI, bid outside that one to take a slim lead around the far turn, failed to contain the winner near the three eighths, gave hard chase from the quarter pole and had enough left to save the place. BOZZINI moved inside to the command after a quarter mile, kicked clear and set a soft pace towards the rail, was headed around the far turn, dropped back under pressure leaving the five sixteenths, shifted out for the drive and kept on with some interest. DIXIE DRAWL, off the pace, circled five wide into the lane and lacked a solid bid. TYBALT broke outward and was away a bit slow, angled in and edged up a bit near the half mile pole, angled four wide for the drive and faded.
