Footnotes

SHARING stalked the pace down the backstretch, moved up three deep leaving the far turn, wrested command near the three sixteenths pole, was under brisk urging and drew away. SUNSET PROMISE hugged the inner rail, disputed the pace with MIDSHIP LADY, repelled that one entering the stretch, lost the lead in upper stretch and gradually faded. LOVE BEACH, snugly rated in the two path between horses around the first turn, remained in the two path on the far turn, eased out turning for home and had a slight rally. MIDSHIP LADY disputed the pace two wide and steadily retreated through the stretch. RISING BELLA raced along the inner rail around both turns and weakened in the drive. SKY KITTEN, four deep the first turn, was outrun. ROMNEY MARSH, three wide both turns, weakened.
