Footnotes

NEWTOME edged up inside early on and gained a stalking position, was coaxed along to hold a forward spot into the lane, made a grinding run along the rail leaving the furlong grounds, kept on under strong handling, bid inside the leader with about seventy yards remaining, gained a slim lead late then got the perfect bob at the wire. INFORMATIVE bobbed at the break and was away last, recovered and settled while towards the inside, followed the winner into the lane, shifted out past the sixteenth pole, surged outside rivals and lost the bob. REFORM SCHOOL was nudged clear early, set the pace toward the rail, was guided three wide soon into the lane, widened a bit nearing mid stretch, was joined from the inside leaving the sixteenth pole but just wasn't quite good enough. SIR BACK IN BLACK prompted the pace two to three wide, was under pressure into the lane, came back slightly inside the final sixteenth but flattened late. RAGING WHISKEY moved up three wide past the five eighths and tracked the leaders, was under urging between rivals mid turn, angled out wider into the lane, advanced with SIR BACK IN BLACK heading towards the sixteenth marker but was out finished. BERNIE'S ON FIRE broke a step slow, was taken four wide, moved up outside rivals leaving the far turn, failed to kick on past the five sixteenths and faltered.
