Footnotes

MORO SAID READY set the pace under pressure, vied along the rail on the turn, shook clear outside the sixteenth-pole and drew away under strong urging. GOOD JUDGMENT pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the turn, battled with the winner into the final furlong, lost touch with that foe into the final sixteenth, drifted out while weakening late and just held the place. LUCKENBACHER was ridden along on the outside, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in while gaining near the sixteenth-pole and finished well to just miss the place while narrowly able to get the show. GOLD PILOT broke a half-step slow, was ridden along on the outside, went four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to just miss the trifecta. WONDERS OF HISLOVE chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn and tired. CAFE GOLD veered in at the start and was slow into stride, was urged along at the back, went two then three wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. CLAMARATOR chased the pace, raced in the two path on the turn, spun three wide into the stretch and came up empty. COLONEL BOWIE was urged along off the pace, raced inside to the two path on the turn and failed to respond.
