MISS J MCKAY showed good speed racing close up three wide, bid passing the quarter pole, drifted in bumping rivals at the eighth pole, then kicked clear. FOOLISH HUMOR away alertly, dueled two wide for the lead, battled between rivals on the turn, was bumped hard at the eighth pole, then continued willingly for second. STRONGERTHANUKNOW dueled inside for the lead, battled on the turn, was bumped hard at the eighth pole, weakened and held on for third. BRAMBLE BERRY raced three wide off the pace, three wide on the turn and rallied mildly late. PINK CADDY raced off the pace between rivals, inside on the turn, lacked a bid and finished evenly. VIRGINIA PEACH raced off the pace inside and did not factor. STREET FLYER raced off the rail, off the pace and was outrun. After a Stewards' Inquiry and Jockey Objection, MISS J MCKAY was disqualified and placed third for bumping rivals at the furlong marker.
