THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$750 to pass the entry box and \$1,500 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made by the closing time of entries at a fee of \$3,000 which qualifies to start with \$150,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. Weights: 122lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 twice allowed 3 lbs.; \$40,000 once 5 lbs.; \$25,000 once 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in allowances.) In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings. (See reverse side for additional starting limitation information). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2019 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. Nominations closed Thursday, January 10, 2019 with 49 nominees.

Footnotes

GRAY ATTEMPT broke readily, was urged clear racing to the first turn while angling over, dictated the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the rail into the backstretch, repelled a challenger racing through the far turn then held LONG RANGE TODDY safe through the stretch to prevail under firm handling. The latter, forwardly placed along the rail tracking just off the pacesetter, was urged to challenge inside that foe entering upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while just outfinished. BOLDOR tracked the pacesetter three deep in second flight, was urged to advance three deep between foes racing into the far turn to challenge the winner, but was outkicked by the top pair. SIX SHOOTER tracked the leader between foes in second flight, was eased back from that position racing into the backstretch, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with interest. SLEEPY EYES TODD tracked off the second flight inside foes in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch, then shifted off the inside while making mild progress late. BANKIT settled outside foes dropping off the second flight, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch but lacked a rally. SUPER STEED settled near the inside racing off the second flight, continued between foes into the far turn but proved no threat. FORLOVEOFCOUNTRY tracked the pace outside foes off the second flight, made some brief progress four wide through the backstretch to gain brief contention but quickly came up empty.
