By subscription of \$750 on Thursday, February 7, 2019 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby, \$2,500 to pass the entry box and \$2,500 additional to start with \$500,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2019, allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 at a mile or over at any time allowed 5 lbs.

(Maiden and Claiming races not considered in allowances). In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings (See reverse side for additional starting limitation information). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2019 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. Nominations closed Thursday, February 7, 2019 with 55 nominees.

Footnotes

SUPER STEED was steadied early off heels when a foe came out, was unrushed, bid five wide at the half-mile, drew off, lost the stick nearing the eighth pole and then lasted under mild urging. SUENO stalked the pace between foes, bid late in the four path outside of the winner and missed. LONG RANGE TODDY stalked the pace inside, was steadied at the quarter pole, split rivals at the three-sixteenths pole and bid late. SIX SHOOTER raced inside, angled five wide at the three-eighths pole, then couldn't close late. BANKIT was floated out early, trailed inside, then closed late six wide. BOLDOR raced evenly. CUTTING HUMOR came out early, bid four wide at the half-mile mark, then faltered in the stretch. JERSEY AGENDA was steadied into the first turn, then pressed the pace outside. NINTH STREET stalked the pace between foes, then faded in the stretch. OLYMPIC RUNNER stalked the pace in the three path, then gave way in the stretch. GRAY ATTEMPT bore out early, led inside, then couldn't last.
