CATMAN came in at the break tightening rivals, prompted the pace two wide, moved to engage the leader after a half mile, dueled from the three eighths to upper stretch, shook clear under a drive with a furlong to go then had just enough left to fend off WOOTTON ASSET (FR). WOOTTON ASSET (FR) broke outward then was bumped and checked, regrouped and moved up early to stalk three wide, took closer order near the five sixteenths, gave hard chase into the lane, kept grinding through the final furlong and had his surge just fall short. KIDNAPPED, fractious behind the starting gate, was forced in by the winner at the break then was bumped and in tight, gathered himself then settled off the pace while saving ground, altered out for room near the three sixteenths, eased out, edged up between foes near the sixteenth marker then hung late. HIDDEN ENEMY (IRE), forced in at the break, raced off the pace and outside a rival near the half mile pole, was under pressure three wide into the lane but failed to generate a solid finish. NAUTILUS drifted in at the break, quickly went clear and set the pace towards the inside, was joined after a half mile, dueled from the three eighths to the three sixteenths then gave in through the last eighth.
