ZAPIT chased the early pace then rallied three wide on the turn, was in a strong drive and drew away in late stretch. POLLY TIZ was settled then rallied on the turn, was five wide in upper stretch and was gaining ground to be up for the place in the end. DIAMONDS N SPURS was settled then rallied two wide in the stretch but was outfinished for the place. JENSEN GRACE was hustled along the inside then saved ground into the turn, swung out to be four wide in upper stretch but raced evenly in the stretch. SWEET MARY M vied for the lead while three wide, was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. QUEEN OF ALVA was unhurried early and was no menace. SPECIAL TREASURE vied for the early lead while inside, was hard used then gave way. GP'S AMAZING GRACE was unhurried early while inside and was no threat. SOONER EXPRESS was outrun. PRINCESS ASYA vied for the lead while between rivals, was hard used then stopped in the stretch.
