ROWDY YATES stalked the pace while three wide into the turn, rallied on the turn and was in a long drive and proved best in the end. FLY TO THE BANK dueled for the lead while inside while in a fast pace into the turn, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch. OKIE HEATER was inside rallied on the turn, swung out to be four wide at the top of the stretch and bumped but came up empty in late stretch. SOUTHGATE rallied five wide on the turn and was bumped slightly at the top of the stretch and was no menace in late stretch. PRETTY SPECIAL was inside on the turn and saving ground but was no menace in late stretch. OKLAHOMA STORM was unhurried early then raced three wide on the turn and was no threat. EUROMANTIC was two wide on the turn and no threat. A GUY LIKE ME dueled for the early lead while two wide in a fast pace then was used up and stopped in the stretch. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of SOUTHGATE against the rider of OKIE HEATER for interference on the turn. After reviewing the film's, no action was taken.
