SENOR BUSCADOR was off a step slow at the start then continued unhurried around the first turn, remained well reserved while racing in the back of the back through the backstretch, was patiently handled around the far turn then swung into action along the far outside entering top stretch, responded sharply when roused for more, quickly rallied past the field and finished going away. COWAN rated near midpack down the backstretch, picked up the pace racing four wide near the quarter pole, hustled along five wide into the lane, advanced to be a sharp contender near the furlong marker then failed to be a match when the winner swept by but stayed on with response to clear second best. RED N WILD settled off the pace, shifted out and launched a bid top of the lane and continued a steady effort to gain a share. SAFFA'S DAY tracked the pace down the backstretch, hustled up three wide around the far turn, shifted out wider top stretch then ran on evenly. OUTADORE was forwardly placed down the backstretch, vied for the lead around the far turn then failed to sustain bid and gave way in the lane. JOE FRAZIER stalked through early stages, urged three wide on the far turn, stayed up close to the furlong marker then came

up empty. VIM AND VIGOR raced off the pace and failed to advance when called upon in the far turn. NUMBER ONE DUDE raced in range along the inside, hustled up around the bend then failed to keep pace and steadily weakened. FLASH OF MISCHIEF set the pace down the backstretch, vied for the lead on the final turn then tired in stretch run. GUSHING OIL raced off the pace then five wide into the lane and failed to move into contention.
