SHAME ON POWERS contended between runners into the turn, was just headed slightly at the top of the stretch but regained a narrow lead thereafter, just held under steady handling. CERVEZA stalked the leaders between foes into the turn, went four to five wide on that bend, appeared to be lightly bumped at the five-sixteenths, took aim and surged late but just missed. SEVEN SILVER COINS pressed from outside going three wide into the turn, came out a bit for the drive, kept on gamely in the late stages but simply needed more. JIM EDD WHO ducked in at the start, tracked from inside and was bumped lightly and in a bit tight near the half-mile marker, moved up to press the leaders from the rail into the turn, proved no match for the top three. ESTEEMED raced last but one early, shifted to the rail entering the turn, saved ground advancing through that bend then came out for the stretch run, faced traffic and steadied slightly near the furlong marker, came out a path for room and ran on well. DECK HUMOR was bumped at the break and while between runners heading up the backstretch, continued to chase mid-pack two to three wide through the turn, went evenly. GO NOW GO lacked early speed despite encouragement early, shifted in a bit entering the turn, came out in upper stretch still last but forced to move in for room and improved position. ANCIENT LAND was bumped into a rival at the start, chased mid-pack and was in tight and bumped the inside foe up the backstretch, went three to four wide on the turn, came out a bit in upper- to mid-stretch and needed more late. FORTY FIVES STORM was caught five to six wide on the turn, failed to rally. TOM T WHO bumped the inside rival at the start, chased four wide and between foes into the turn but steadily dropped back and faded.
