MUCHO GUSTO had speed three deep then stalked off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter on the second turn, took the lead leaving that turn, inched away in the stretch and drew clear under left handed urging and a long hold late. GUNMETAL GRAY settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and edged a rival late for the place. EASY SHOT a bit slow to begin, saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, went outside a rival in midstretch and was edged late for second. MAGNIFICENT MCCOOL had speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, inched away into the backstretch, kicked clear inside, fought back along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. KID CANTINA had good early speed inside, dueled along the rail, stalked into the backstretch, took a bad step early on the backstretch and was pulled up in distress and vanned off. KID CANTINA wore calks.
