MESSIER vied along the inside with a pair of rivals, inched ahead at the seven-sixteenths pole, shook free from CABO SPIRIT with a quarter mile left to run, then powered away under hand urging and widened to the wire. CABO SPIRIT vied three deep to the far turn, pressured MESSIER around the bend then lost touch approaching the quarter pole, churned on through the lane and finished a clear second. WHARTON went three wide around the first turn, continued off the rail to the second bend, came four wide into the stretch and gained the show. SIR LONDON stumbled leaving the gate, recovered and went up to vie between rivals, could not keep pace past the seven-sixteenths pole, chased near the inside to the stretch and tired. HAPPY JACK settled on the inside, tipped three wide leaving the far turn and failed to menace.
