1^{1/8} MILES. (1.39) 79TH RUNNING OF THE ROBERT B. LEWIS GRADE III. Purse \$150,000 FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each to accompany the nomination, closed Thursday, January 26, 2017 with 3 or by supplementary nomination of \$3,000 at time of entry. \$2,250 additional to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed. The winner to receive \$90,000 PLUS 10 KENTUCKY DERBY POINTS, \$30,000 (Four Points) to second, \$18,000 (Two Points) to third, \$9,000 (One Point) to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Stake at One Mile or Over, allowed 2 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes, allowed 4 lbs. Horses with the highest earnings at time of entry have preference after allowances. All Early Bird nominees to the 2017 Santa Anita Derby (Closed Wednesday, December 28, 2016 with 98) are automatically eligible to the Robert B. Lewis Stakes with all fees waived. All entered horses are Early Bird Santa Anita Derby nominees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

ROYAL MO went up inside to the early lead, set a pressured pace along the rail, inched away under urging in midstretch and won clear. IRAP pulled his way along off the rail then bid outside the winner on the first turn, pressed the pace while lapped on that one to the stretch, could not match strides in the final furlong and just held second. SHEER FLATTERY four wide into the first turn, angled in and chased a bit off the rail then inside, moved up inside leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and just missed the place. TERM OF ART angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DANGERFIELD three deep into the first turn, chased between rivals then outside a foe, drifted out into the stretch and weakened.
