under left handed urging and drew off under a long hold late, then was unsaddled at the end of the stretch and vanned off. ILIAD stalked three deep then bid three wide on the backstretch and second turn, angled in outside a rival into the stretch and held second. TERM OF ART bobbled at the start, settled off the pace inside, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. GORMLEY stalked just off the rail on the first turn then bid between horses to press the pace on the backstretch and second turn, drifted in entering the stretch, drifted out some from the whip in midstretch and weakened. ANN ARBOR EDDIE a bit slow to begin, was fanned out some into the first turn then angled in and chased outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and gave way. BLUEGRASS ENVY four wide into the first turn, angled in and chased just off the rail or outside a rival and had little left for the stretch. VENDING MACHINE drifted out into the first turn, angled in and chased inside, dropped back and came out into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
