PERFECT ALIBI four wide just off the pace in pursuit down the backstretch, tucked to the two path half a mile from home remained patiently handled and swung three wide into upper stretch in behind a wall of rivals, had JUST FLY take a left turn at the three-sixteenths and went on through the newly opened seam between foes, came in slightly hooking up head to head a furlong out and putting the pinch on BIG Q inside that station in tandem with FRANK'S ROCKETTE, dug in under drive dueling to the finish and displacing MAGIC DANCE from command a sixteenth out, then prevailed gamely at the wire. FRANK'S ROCKETTE chased three wide from just off the pace until tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, got bumped and pinched due to pressure from JUST FLY coming in under an off sided stick bumping INTEGRAL and in turn placed BIG Q in tight along the rail, slipped through a narrow opening emerging to knock heads with PERFECT ALIBI through the final eighth overtaking the leader as a pair a sixteenth out and showed good courage to battle to the finish but was ultimately bested at the end. MAGIC DANCE stumbled badly at the start pecking the ground while losing some of her traction in behind and then got bumped by JUST FLY conceding only one to two lengths to the front, chased seven paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide into the turn, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, rallied in the clear outside the traffic jam along the inside to take command a furlong from home, dug in and yielded a sixteenth out while showing good courage to be along for the show honors despite the unideal beginning. MISS PEPPINA five to six wide in pursuit down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, kept on for the last major share. BIG Q just off the inside in pursuit from near the rear, tucked inside half a mile from hom

as the inside tightened up briefly as FRANK'S ROCKETTE and PERFECT ALIBI went on by and weakened to the finish thereafter. MYLASTFIRSTKISS broke in at the start bumping INTEGRAL, chased four to five wide down the backstretch and then two to three wide through the turn under coaxing from the three-eighths, swung four to five wide for home and offered no response. INTEGRAL bumped at thje start by the aforementioned foe, established the front and showed the way from the five path before tucking over to take up position on the inside through the turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, dug in under threat from a host and yielded the front getting bumped by JUST FLY who came in under an off sided stick and in turn bumped and pinched FRANK'S ROCKETTE and also BIG Q down along the rail and folded. JUST FLY broke out at the start bumping MAGIC DANCE as that foe recovered from a stumble, chased six to seven paths off the inside until tucked to the two path through the turn, swung three wide for home, shied in under an off sided stick bumping INTEGRAL into FRANK'S ROCKETTE and in turn BIG Q, got pinched back soon after, faltered and was eased through the final eighth.
