GREEN LIGHT GO settled nicely off the pace, moved closer outside the half-mile, drafted in the two path while full of run early on the turn, was given his cue while shifting three wide at the five-sixteenths, rallied outside into upper stretch, drifted in then brushed with TUGGLE while taking the lead at the three-sixteenths, shook clear after being put to a left-handed whip at the furlong marker, switched to a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole then was given two strikes before being eased up while much the best. NOOSE came in while breaking near the back of the field, settled towards the rear of the field, saved ground while roused on the turn, swung three wide into the stretch then came under the whip and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. TUGGLE disputed the pace on the inside of LONG WEEKEND, vied along the rail while still inside of that foe on the turn, turned into the stretch under a strong hand ride, lost the lead while brushed by the winner at the three-sixteenths, dropped back under a drive into the final furlong and weakened while clear for the show. PERUVIAN BOY settled near the back of the field, went four wide on the turn, dropped to three wide into the stretch, came between horses nearing the sixteenth-pole and failed to threaten. ZYRAMID showed speed on the inside then dropped back outside the half-mile pole, fell further back under urging leaving the backstretch, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to respond. LONG WEEKEND contested the pace on the outside, was urged along outside of TUGGLE in the two path on the turn, dropped back under a drive into upper stretch and tired. IBERICO broke a bit awkwardly from the outside post and was last to commence, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three then four wide on the turn, dropped back while five wide into the stretch and faded.
