Footnotes

GOT STORMY away in good order, worked out a tuck along the hedge approaching the conclusion of the homestretch, was patiently ridden in midpack in the main flight keeping watch on the runaway leader from afar, picked it up and closed as the gap in unison with all the others during the run around the far turn, angled three wide onto the head of the stretch, closed in readily while being ridden out during the ensuing furlong, departed the eighth pole engaged in an one on one contest with MADE YOU LOOK, was called upon for more and gave the desired response, putting away the nemesis by the sixteenth pole, edged away, en route to establishing a course record. RAGING BULL (FR) quickly set up the inside route, took it until end of the backstretch, was eased into the two path departing the half mile pole, got cued up for the drive home, was maneuvered into path six, becoming the widest of all, during the opening stages of the stretch run, closed in once straightened up, out-fought a threesome in the final stages to get up for the place. UNI (GB) made it over to the hedge well before arriving at the crown of the clubhouse bend, stayed put stalking GIDU, was called upon cutting the corner into the stretch, steadied altering course to the outside of a weakening DR. EDGAR in midstretch, split opponents late and got up for the show. MARCH TO THE ARCH rode the hedge, was under strong handling cutting the corner into the stretch, tipped out towards path five in the lane, was vying with vigour late against several others for a major check, had to settle for fourth. MADE YOU LOOK along the inside on the first turn, went into the two path stepping onto the backstretch, led the charge on GIDU on the second bend, was given his cue challenging in earnest coming up to the three-sixteenths marker, took over, was soon pounced upon by the eventual winner, yielded after putting up a fight for the next sixteenth, weakened late. HEMBREE took up the chase two wide for three-quarters, swung five wide into the lane, settled in and mustered up a mild response. DR. EDGAR two wide early, traded paths with MADE YOU LOOK leaving the first turn, tracked GIDU loosely pocketed, tipped into the two path for the drive home, bid until the furlong grounds then backed away. KRAMPUS took the two path in pursuit of the pace for the opening three-quarters, commenced the stretch slightly wide, lacked a response. GIDU (IRE) keen seemingly from the get-go, sprinted off from path two, cut over to the rail and went about in a more professional manner after stepping onto the far turn, saw the competition rapidly close the gap, retreated after getting overhauled in the general area of the three-sixteenths pole. OSTILIO (GB) taken in hand as the winner was crossing over right after the field had been sent off and running, was parked out three wide on the opening bend, was one path closer to the inside on the subsequent one, completed three-quarters and folded.
