FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than claiming allowed 2 lbs.; maidens allowed 4 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday, August 3, 2019 with 21 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the Main Track).

Footnotes

KIMARI moved up to take the lead, pulled outward on the bit while setting the pace on the outside of two foes, was nursed around the turn in the two path while still getting out a touch, responded well when set down once straightened for the drive, came under a right-handed whip while extending the advantage into the final furlong, switched back to her inside lead nearing the sixteenth-pole then was placed under a strong hand ride to the wire while much the best. ABSCOND pressed the pace while loosely between horses, dropped back passing the seven-sixteenths then moved out into the turn, re-bid outside of the winner in the three path on that bend, was asked outside the quarter-pole, lost touch with the winner under a drive in upper stretch and proved no match while able to get the place. CHAMPAGNE HUMOR brushed with an opponent at the start, tracked the pace on the outside then in the four path on the turn, came under increased pressure into the stretch, chased the winner past the three-sixteenths and weakened but held the show. VAST was hustled from the start, pressed the pace on the inside of two foes, vied along the rail on the turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, came under the whip in upper stretch, bumped with CLASSY SADIE outside the furlong marker and tired. CLASSY SADIE brushed with a foe at the start, moved in early then was rated at the rear while just behind horses, drafted in the three path on the turn, was asked in the vicinity of the quarter-pole, came in under a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker then bumped with VAST and came up empty. PERSIAN QUEEN settled towards the back of the compact field, dropped to the rear in the two path on the turn, was asked while shifting three wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
