## Footnotes

SWISS SKYDIVER kept abreast of CRYSTAL BALL as the twosome made their way towards the clubhouse bend, was firmly held accompanying that opponent two to three wide, moved when ready at the midway point of the far turn, wresting away the advantage even with the nemesis having been asked for more run by this juncture, extended the margin unasked the remainder of the way to the quarter pole, arrived at the three-sixteenths pole and saw the rider switch over to stronger handling, best described as being ridden out, opened up a commanding lead by the beginning of the final furlong, was still in possession of a healthy one prior to being wrapped up for the final seventy yards. BONNY SOUTH put to a snug hold after springing from the gate, glided over to the rail, contently tracked the pace towards the back of the pack, was asked to pick up interest angling to the outside at the quarter pole, completed the maneuver approximately three wide, overhauled HARVEY'S LIL GOIL, then cut into the deficit late on the geared down winner. HARVEY'S LIL GOIL recovered in short order after stumbling at the start, chased the pace three wide, scurried into contention with a sustained run around the second bend, turned into the lane, couldn't keep pace with the top one over the course of the next furlong, flattened out late and lost out on place honors. ENVOUTANTE took up residence in the pocket after the field had been sent on its way, was rated along staying within striking distance of the front runners, idled behind the weakening former pacesetter during the final stages of the run around the far turn, slipped to the outside in time to get sterred four wide into the stretch, got outfinished. CRYSTAL BALL under some encouragement establishing the top, was just off the rail showing the way, pressed by the confidently-ridden SWISS SKYDIVER to her outside, came under a ride after departing the backstretch, got swallowed up nonetheless about a furlong later, stepped into the lane and backed away. SPICE IS NICE remained in path two after the start, was between rivals until the general area of the three-eighths pole, required some hand urging to keep pace travelling on the backstretch, was then more feverishly ridden after stepping onto turn two, fell back, was allowed to fade away in the final furlong. FIRE CORAL strung out three wide, was under some urging by midway on the backstretch, retreated after leaving the half mile pole, was put to milder urging by midstretch and allowed to fade away.
