FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than claiming allowed 2 lbs.; maidens allowed 4 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday, August 3, 2019 with 13 Original Nominations and 2 Supplements. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the Main Track).

**Footnotes**

ANOTHER MIRACLE overhauled by MONTAUK DADDY approaching the conclusion of the backstretch, went on to loosely draft behind that opponent from path two during the run around the bend, was under a drive swinging three wide into the lane, closed in readily on the one to catch, struck the front end with approximately a sixteenth to go and kicked clear. PROVEN STRATEGIES made it over to the inside by the half mile pole, was patiently handled keeping an eye on the runaway leader, got cued up angling four wide into the stretch, straightened away, then closed the gap in a steadfast manner to get up at the wire for second. MONTAUK DADDY keen pulling on the left, sprinted off from the others, was still comfortably in the clear leading the field into the stretch, got reeled in in the general area of the sixteenth marker, lost the place in the last jump. MEMORABLE rushed up during the opening sixteenth to secure some position on the backstretch, continued along the hedge until the end of the bend, got spotted into path two for the drive home, grabbed the last major check, accomplished without impact. NOW IS strung out three wide on the turn, got sent out into path five early during the stretch, lacked the a solid closing punch. VENERATE travelled three wide on the turn, shifted a bit nearer the inside once into the stretch, never made his presence felt. FROSTED ROSE stationed along the inside route by the half mile pole, shifted four wide heading home to no avail. RIVER HAWK underwent a two wide pursuit, moved inward in time to cut the corner into the lane, came up empty.
