ANNALS OF TIME away in good order, cut over to the inside, was content to ride the hedge around the first two turns, rating kindlly, was eased to the outside and into the two path shortly after leaving the second bend, continued to pursue the front runners held in reserve, waited behind foes approaching the quarter pole, surveying the scene before getting committed to a course of action, got cued up angling five wide to attain optimal clearance, straightened and closed in readily travelling through the furlong grounds, loomed a serious threat by the start of the final furlong, displayed good courage vying as the widest of as many as five at one time leaving the eighth pole, beat SADLER'S JOY to the punch thern dug in to hold sway. SADLER'S JOY settled into midpack along the two path during the journey on the first turn, inched its way into path three after departing the homestretch, remained well held stalking the front runners, swung four wide into the lane and was turned loose, clawed his way into contention over the course of the next eighth, shouldered its way between rivals with approximately a sixteenth to go and into better racing room, finished willingly but had to settle for the place. CHANNEL CAT put to firm hold by the pilot sat within range of the pace in the two path, was gradually maneuvered into the three path after stepping onto the clubhouse bend, stayed within striking distance, got cued up challenging for the top entering the stretch the second time, forged his way to a slim advantage by the eighth pole, vied from between rivals leaving that station trying to protect it, relinquished for good about a sixteenth later, stayed on for the show. CHANNEL MAKER three wide stepping onto the first turn, moved closer to the hedge as the first fraction was being finalized, prompted YA PRIMO pulling on the bit all the way to the guarter pole, was between rivals spinning into the lane and would then battle under such conditions until the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, weakened late. NOBLE THOUGHT was moved onto the inside route after losing his footing springing from the gate, slipped into the two path midway on the backstretch for the second time, ventured onward being rated, took off with good energy when roused entering the stretch, put in a bid for the next furlong before flattening out. PILLAR MOUNTAIN (IRE) took up the chase from path two, was switched over to a brisk hand ride approaching the five-sixteenths marker, fanned out into path five from upper to midstretch, made no impact. PROVEN RESERVES rode the hedge, got sent three wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. TIZ MORNING faltered after undergoing a ground-saving journey. YA PRIMO (CHI) went over to the inside after establishing a co-share of the top at the midway point of the opening bend, showed the way, shadowed by CHANNEL MAKER in path two, got roused up coming under siege heading home, succumbed and backed away.
