For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$3,500 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden allowed 2 lbs; maidens allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. BASIN the quickest springing from the starting gate, was allowed to drop back as a tussel commenced between AMERICAN BUTTERFLY and GOZILLA, sat perched three wide with a good view of the ongoing pace dispute during the run around the bend, swung into action by swinging approximately five onto the top of the lane, was instructed to switch leads with a few taps in the general area of the right shoulder prior to getting set down at the three-sixteenths marker, mustered up a strong run to scoot past the fighting front runners, came out momentarily after some left side stick work, didn't do so a few strides later when put to some pressure from the same side, drew off smartly. SHOPLIFTED well rated taking the inside route until the conclusion of the backstretch, went about the turn with the pilot utilizing hand encouragement, angled three wide for the drive home, closed in on the ones to catch in a steadfast manner to get up for second. GOZILLA got engaged with AMERICAN BUTTERFLY shortly after the field had been sent on its way, participated in it from the two path, being the one of that twosome clinging to a slim advantage, was still holding it spinning into the lane in reserve, contrasting the drive the nemesis has just been put to, saw the rider go to work a sixteenth down the road, with BASIN having made its presence felt, proved no match, ventured onward losing ground to the aforementioned opponent, wound up getting necked for the place. AMERICAN BUTTERFLY sent over to the inside after the start, duelled on near even terms with GOZILLA, was the first of that pairing to have its pilot commit to a drive, this occurring at the quarter pole, put up a fight until midstretch before giving way. BY YOUR SIDE strung out three to four wide on the turn, fanned out into path during the initial portion of the stretch, made no headway. INSIDE RISK left the post parade early to be given a strong and prolonged warm up, proceeded to come away in good order, settled into path two, was well reserved during the initial stages, partnered up with SHOPLIFTED, got driven four wide into the lane, had no rally.
