STAKES Hopeful S. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. This is a Non-Lasix race pursuant to 4043.2 (7)(e)(5) Lasix not permitted within 48 hours of post time. By subscription of \$300 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$3,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden allowed 2 lbs; maidens allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, August 21, 2021 with 27 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement.

GUNITE bumped with a rival at the start and was a bit slow into stride, rushed up to join the leaders at the nine-sixteenths, vied inside of two foes from that point, shook clear inside the five-sixteenths, responded well when put to a right-handed crop in upper stretch and drew away under strong urging. WIT stumbled awkwardly at the start and was off slow, spotted the front several lengths, made a steady advance under urging on the backstretch, chased inside to the two path on the turn, was driven three wide in pursuit of the winner into the stretch and safely secured the place while unable to go with the winner. KEVIN'S FOLLY showed speed then chased the pace, dropped back while moving from the two path to the rail on the turn and tired while able to get the show. HIGH OAK was well placed while coaxed along down the backstretch, chased three wide on the turn, was driven five wide into the stretch and came up empty. POWER AGENDA lost his footing at the start then bumped with a foe after the break, was urged along on the outside, went three to four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. BIG SCULLY bumped with a rival shortly after the start, was urged along towards the rear, went four wide on the turn, came seven wide into the stretch and was no factor. VOLCANIC broke out then hit the gate and was off a step slow, was urged along towards the rear, rounded the turn in the two path, swung five wide into the stretch and never reached contention. HEADLINE REPORT showed good

speed and set the early pace, was joined near the nine-sixteenths, vied in the three path while outside of two foes on the turn, dropped back four wide into the stretch then drifted in at the three-sixteenths and capitulated. KITODAN bumped with a rival at the start then quickly dropped back, fell well behind, raced inside early on the turn, shifted three wide outside the five-sixteenths and was no factor. DEFEND broke out at the start, lugged out while showing early speed, lost his footing coming to the three-quarter pole then was taken up, moved back up to dispute the pace between horses, vied in the two path while still between foes on the turn, dropped back coming to the quarter-pole and faltered then was eased in the final furlong but walked off. STREET FIGHT bumped with an opponent just after the start then was hustled, raced off the pace while ridden along, dropped back with a half-mile to run and also faltered then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.
