SLOW DOWN ANDY dueled inside a rival but off the fence, edged away leaving the far turn while drifting five wide coming out of that bend, was challenged by a rival in upper stretch being headed by that one who was far outside but dug in under steady handling to hold sway. BYE BYE BOBBY stalked three wide off the dueling leaders, advanced on the far turn floating seven wide into upper stretch and putting a narrow head in front, drifted out a bit and lost control but kept on gamely. PEPPER SPRAY bumped a rival lightly at the start, was caught four wide early, began to pass rivals three wide on the far turn, captured show honors but was no threat to the top pair. FOWLER BLUE settled off the leaders inside on or off the rail, shifted out at the half-mile marker, went three to four wide on the far turn, needed more. CHROME KING was bumped both sides at the start, raced last but one five wide on the first turn, advanced heading into the far turn swinging seven wide out of that bend, evened out in the lane. COSTA TERRA failed to threaten after racing inside on or just off the fence. STRAIGHT UP G bumped a rival at the start, dueled outside the winner three wide, drifted five wide leaving the far turn while weakening, faded. CLASSIC MOMENT was mid-pack inside early, dropped back, pulled up in the stretch, vanned off.
