

SOMELIKEITHOTBROWN vied for the lead early on, took over command, was on the inside into the lane then drew clear in the stretch while drifting in and out but was geared down the final stages. DYNAMIC RACER stalked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn, made a bid down the lane, drifted in a bit and was no match for the winner in the final stages. MOONSTER was sent hard from the gate but back early on, swung into the six path in the far turn, rallied down the lane with a late gain in the final stages. FIVE STAR GENERAL vied for the lead early on, was on the inside into the lane and faltered late in the stretch run. DABO was back early on, swung into the six path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. SPEED APP chased the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and faded down the lane. COUNTER OFFER was never a threat. SKYWIRE was bumped going into the first turn, chased the early pace, angled off the rail into the lane and was empty in the stretch. CURLIN GREY was never a factor. TWELFTHOFNEVERLAND was through after a half. BAYTOWN JIMBO had early speed then folded up.
