EASY SWITCH broke out, saved ground and raced up close on the turn then weakened in the drive. DANGERSMYMIDDLNAME between foes early, raced in the five path into the lane and lacked a bid. MUY BUENO also between rivals early, weakened on the turn. ARIZONA SUN came in at the start, trailed into the turn while racing outside, was six wide turning for home and lacked a response in a dull effort.
