Footnotes

ABSCOND broke sharply but outward, sprinted clear, was joined in a duel on the main track, was headed upper stretch, battled back bravely and got up on the wire. WALK IN MARRAKESH (IRE) forced the pace briefly then drew even, dueled through the turn, drove to the lead upper stretch, was all out but was caught on the wire. FAIR MAIDEN stalked the pace, closed three and four-wide on the turn, was up close through the stretch and was under a strong drive but drifted out late. DIAMOND SPARKLES, away slowly, settled off the pace, angled from the rail to three-wide on the turn then was all out in the stretch and gaining late. SECRET STASH (IRE) settled in mid pack, steadied sharply early turn then was hustled four-wide and finished under a determined drive. SARATOGA VISION stalked the pace, came two and three-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out in the final furlong. RUNWAY DREAMER stalked the pace, was steadied mid backstretch, rode the rail on the turn but lacked a closing response.
