Footnotes

MUSKOKA GOLD led early then stalked the pace, pressed on the turn, moved to a clear lead upper stretch and held stubbornly. PLEASECALLMEBACK stalked the pace, loomed three-wide at the top of the stretch, was repelled by the leader but was clearly second best. KUNAL broke well but was taken back to trail, weaved through traffic in the stretch and found his best stride late. MORE CHANCES raced in mid pack, came two to four-wide on hold on the turn, loomed dangerous at the top of the stretch but was outkicked. NORTHERN THUNDER broke in the air, rushed up the rail to mid pack, angled out in the stretch then finished evenly. CRYPTIC GRIP had a perfect trip along the rail, chased into the stretch but his rally stalled a furlong out. MALIBU MAMBO

chased four to six-wide through the turn and was inching up wide in the late stages. FANTASTIC BREEZE was shuffled back from mid pack to off the pace on the backstretch, came two and three-wide through the turn, had striking range but leveled off in the stretch. BARILKO settled off the pace, circled two to five-wide through the turn, was fanned wide at the top of the stretch and flattened out late. GOLDMINE CAT pressed the leader throughout, gained a brief lead late turn and retreated in the stretch. MUSKOKA GIANT raced in mid pack, was shuffled back three-wide on the turn and offered no response in the stretch. PERFECT REVENGE chased three-wide, rallied five-wide on the turn, loomed up at the top of the stretch but backed away.
