

CHAPALU showed early speed, led into the first turn, set a reserved pace, quickened on the far turn, drifted out in the late stages but held under a hand ride. MUSKOKA GOLD settled off the pace, circled three to five-wide and under a hard drive on the far turn then was all out through the stretch and gained steadily, but missed. LOOKINATAMIRACLE broke slowly and lost his path, settled in mid pack, closed two to four-wide on the far turn then finished under a determined drive. TORRES DEL PAINE showed early speed but was beaten to the first turn, stalked the pacesetter, chased hard on the far turn and was all out through the stretch. FINALIST raced in mid pack, was hustled angling from the rail to three-wide on the final turn, encountered traffic upper stretch and rallied between foes. NORTHERN THUNDER hopped inward at the start, settled off the pace, was hustled two to four-wide on the turn tipped out at the top of the stretch and finished gamely. BEL BIMBO hopped leaving the gate, settled off the pace, was hustled two-wide on the turn but never reached contention. GREEN GROWTH, in range, was hustled two and three-wide on the far turn, was roused but offered no response. INSIDE RISK, in range, was

hustled from the rail on the far turn then flattened out in the final 16th.
