Footnotes

STEPHEN hopped out of the gate, raced in mid pack, was hustled on the far turn, chased from the rail in the stretch, moved off the fence to setter clear of the pacesetter in mid stretch, had the lead quickly and was ridden out. TIO MAGICO held a short but pressured lead, quickened on the far turn, was lugging in and veered in three or four-times in the stretch and did not straighten away under his rider used his crop but it was too late. GIANT WATERS stalked the pace, chased two to four-wide on the far turn then finished gamely. MASTER SPY broke inward and pressed the pace, forced the issue on the far turn but gave way upper stretch. BRITISH ROYALTY hit the gate leaving and settled off the pace, chased angling from the rail to three-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. ONE FLINT stalked the pace, chased along the rail through the far turn but evened out in the final furlong. THREEFIFTYSEVEN stalked the pace, was hustled three to five-wide on the far turn then flattened out at the top of the stretch. FLEX stalked early, dropped back on the far turn and lacked a rally.
