FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS, Sired by a Stallion Standing in Ontario for his entire season the year of

conception and registered with the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society for that season. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$1,000 when making entry. Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$2,000, which includes the entry fee. (Closed with 19 nominations) *Plus up to \$10,500 Ontario Sired/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. *\$85,000 of this purse has been provided through the Thoroughbred Improvement Program.

Footnotes

DOTTED LINE chased the two leaders along the inside, got through a very tight spot on the rail as the frontrunners drifted out as they turned for home, stuck his head in front before the eighth pole and would not relinquish the lead in the final stages. ARTIE'S PRINCESS stalked the early leader without being asked, bid for the lead late on the turn when drifting out with the besieged frontrunner, had a brief lead in upper stretch but was immediately engaged to her inside by the winner, battling on gamely but second best. TORPEDO MAX was three wide in mid pack, came five wide late on the turn into range, fell back as they turned for home but gathered himself up and re-rallied stoutly to nail the show spot in the final few yards. CRAFTY CONQUEST broke out at the start and fell off the pace along the inside, followed the winner on the turn along the fence, angled out to look dangerous as they turned for home but could not match the energy of the top pair, and lost the show spot late. FORESTER'S TURN brushed the side of the gate at the start, tracked the leaders outside the eventual winner, drifted out to four wide late on the turn, ducked in and jumped onto his wrong lead in upper stretch, straightening out late and showing some interest in the final seventy yards. PRICELESS WILL was three wide throughout, roused by the rider late on the turn and did close mildly inside the final furlong. ROCKCREST led early, was pressed by the eventual place horse on the turn, drifted off the rail letting the winner inside him as they

turned for home, fading down the stretch. AGNELLI was two wide and off the pace, roused along the rail on the turn but did not respond. CRYPTIC GRIP hesitated slightly at the start and fell back to four wide off the pace, never entering the picture.
