HALO AGAIN chased along the rail throughout, was in range into the far turn but dropped back midway through that turn, roused by the rider to re-rally as the field turned for home, dipped back inside the tiring frontrunners at the sixteenth pole to stick his head in front, gamely outfinishing the place horse to the wire. MALIBU MAMBO was off the pace and trailing as the field went down the backstretch, circled the pack two to five wide on the far turn, came widest into the stretch and closed relentlessly while outside to just miss to the rail skimming winner. MUSKOKA GOLD stumbled and bumped a rival at the start, was four wide off the pace through the first turn, came three to four wide into range on the second turn, loomed dangerously in upper stretch but couldn't match the closing kick of the top pair, still inching up late while inside the place finisher. GREEN GROWTH led early setting a moderate pace, had an open length advantage until confronted by a rival at the quarter pole, shook that one off to open up in upper stretch but succumbed to the closers at the sixteenth pole, hanging on for a minor award. TOMCAT BLACK two path stalked the early leader, took a run at him late on the second turn and into the stretch but could not get by, tiring and losing positions inside the final sixteenth. NORTHERN THUNDER was bumped by a rival at the start, fell off the pace and three wide through the first turn, two to four wide around the second turn and did close mildly late to be in behind the the top five. PLEASECALLMEBACK was in mid pack and three wide through the opening turn, loomed three wide at the quarter pole but could not sustain the rally, losing his path in upper stretch, falling back from that point. KUNAL took up somewhat at the start, settled along the rail in mid pack, was under restraint by the rider from midway first turn to midway far turn, then had no response when given his head and allowed to run.
