ATTILIANNO broke outwardly, tucked in about three then two wide entering the turn moving up to mid-division, came out for the stretch drive about five wide past the furlong marker, engaged in a duel outside ON A WARPATH, was bumped several times by that rival in late stretch but still able to get up. ON A WARPATH attended the pace from well off the inside, came in three abreast to contend through the turn, took command edging clear into upper stretch, drifted out and bumped the aforementioned repeatedly while under left-handed urging and was ultimately denied. FRANCHISE TAGGED exchanged a light bump at the start, was forwardly-placed along the rail contending through the turn, kept on for show honors. CERVEZA contended between rivals and had no extra for the drive. SHAME ON POWERS was encouraged forward at the start and shifted in, tracked the leading trio going five then four wide on the turn, drifted in then out in upper stretch bumping DECK HUMOR late. DECK HUMOR advanced outside foes six then five wide on the turn, was bumped in late stretch. FAST STEPPIN exchanged a light bump at the start, settled at the rear, came into the stretch four deep shifting out two paths late for room and ran on. ROAD TO HEAT chased in behind on or just off the rail and inside foes, had no rally. EVACUEE steadied at the start, urged along, saved ground and made no bid. TOM T WHO chased briefly from between foes then steadily weakened. JIM EDD WHO was in tight at the break and not a factor.
