Weights; 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake allowed 2 lbs. \$15,000 allowed 4 lbs. (maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to Twelve (12) starters with preference to horses with highest lifetime earnings at time of entry. MAIUS tracked the early pace, went six wide into the turn, drifted out in early stretch, angled back in, took control in late stretch and edged clear for the win. PARTY TOWN forced the early pace, raced along the inside through the turn, was no match late and finished second best. COMPETITIVE IDEA pressed the early pace, went four wide into the turn and finished evenly late. RECORDER was void of any early speed, circled seven wide through the turn and offered no late rally. JURISDICTION set a pressured early pace, raced between rivals and tired. HERACLITUS was unhurried early and never fired.
