Footnotes

ANCIENT LAND stalked just off the leaders racing about three to four wide early, took closer order on the far turn launching a bid still three to four wide leaving the far turn, took the lead in mid-stretch, drifted a bit but held sway. GO NOW GO settled mid-pack near the inside in the early going, switched out for the run up the backstretch advancing three to four wide and between foes into the far turn, steadied just slightly and altered out to avoid a drifting ANCIENT LAND late but had too much to do to overcome that rival while annexing the place. EVACUEE shifted in three to four wide under mild rating early, advanced into the far turn while angling to the rail leaving that bend, ran on gamely inside foes late to just miss the place. ON A WARPAT pressed the pace of ROAD TO HEAT while well clear of others, took the lead by upper stretch but had no extra in the late stages when confronted by rivals inside and out. CERVEZA raced off the leaders four to five wide early, advanced quickly six deep into the far turn, continued about five wide on that bend reaching striking distance but evened out for the drive. ROAD TO HEAT was urged forward at the break, set a pressured pace inside but just off the fence, weakened. NOBODY KNOWS WHO raced toward the rear outside in the early going, went mostly four to six deep throughout and ran on evenly. VEIV FROM THE BAY saved ground through the first turn, failed to rally. SHAME ON POWERS got away alertly, was forwardly-positioned three wide into the first turn, shifted in and gradually weakened. TOM T WHO was in tight at the break and never a threat. MORE ACTION broke outwardly, chased four to five wide

early, faded.
